Vacancies for Trustees

Organisation

Peak District Mosaic is a registered charity, looking to expand representation on the Board of Trustees and have vacancies for new Trustees. You don't have to have been a Trustee before. We are looking for people who are passionate about the outdoor environment and enjoy working with people. Life experience, volunteering, community involvement and personal passion are valued as much as work-based knowledge and skills.

This is a great opportunity to bring your knowledge and expertise to Peak District Mosaic's Board of Trustees, to contribute to the direction of our organisation. The successful candidate will work at Board level and the role will also aid personal/professional development. You will help to strengthen the team and be proactive in the governance and development of the charity, to make a real, tangible and lasting difference to participants who become involved in Peak District Mosaic's activities/events.

Peak District Mosaic works closely with the Peak District National Park Engagement Rangers and Derbyshire Dales Council for Voluntary Services.

Aim

Our aim is to create and sustain engagement between the Peak District National Park and new audiences, including Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic (BAME) communities living around the borders of the Peak District National Park. We do this by organising visits and activities that are fun but also develop knowledge, skills and new friendships. We take an active role in promoting and protecting this wonderful place for all, especially for future generations.

Objectives

To provide or assist in the provision of facilities in and around the borders of the Peak District National Park, North York Moors National Park and Yorkshire Dales National Park for education, recreation or other leisure time occupation in the interests of social welfare for individuals who have need of such facilities by reason of their race, ethnic origin, youth, age, infirmity, disability, social circumstances or for the public at large, with the object of improving their conditions of life.

New Project

We are undergoing an exciting period of development with our new project, Championing National Parks for Everyone (CNPfE), funded by the National Lottery Heritage Fund. This project aims to expand our work which is being developed in partnership with the Yorkshire Dales, North York Moors and Peak District National Parks. We are interested in receiving applications from people living in these National Parks or areas near to them, including Nottingham, Birmingham, Greater Manchester, Bradford, Leeds, Middlesbrough and South Yorkshire.

We want to hear from anyone who feels they would make a good Trustee and help build our team. We are also keen to hear from anyone who:

- has expertise/experience in Finance, to act as the charity's **Treasurer** - our current Treasurer is stepping down in 2026, and our new Treasurer will work with the charity's existing Finance and Business Planning committee to maintain an overview of Peak District Mosaic's financial affairs.

- Has an interest in joining our **Activities and Communications committee** who are responsible for overseeing, managing and promoting the schedule of group activities in the Peak District National Park and surrounding areas.
- Possesses strong administrative skills and can take on the responsibilities of the **Secretary**, working with the Chairperson to organise and minute board meetings, and support the overall administration of the charity

We ask that all Trustees;

- Commit to the aims and objectives of Peak District Mosaic
- Have an ability to work effectively as part of a team, contributing an independent perspective
- Possess integrity, objectivity, accountability and honesty
- Are legally eligible to stand as a registered Charity Trustee
- Have had experience of work (voluntary or paid)

Time Commitment and where we work

- We generally expect Trustees to serve for a minimum term of three years. You will be required to attend bi-monthly scheduled meetings of the Board of Trustees, Committee meetings and some ad hoc meetings.
- Our bi-monthly Trustee meetings are held either in person in the Peak District on a Saturday daytime, or held on a weekday in the evenings online (via GoogleMeet). Trustees are expected to join one of the Charity's committees (Activities and Communications; Finance and Business Planning; Partnerships) and take part in meetings for these too.
- The minimum time commitment is approximately 2-3 days per month however, there could be occasions when extra time might be required (e.g. during planning of new projects, or leading on some aspects of our work).
- The role is unpaid however, reasonable expenses are payable in line with Peak District Mosaic's Finance policy.
- Applicants should demonstrate a genuine willingness to commit time to this voluntary role, ensuring consistent and meaningful contributions to our team and the communities we serve.

Applying for the role of Trustee

We welcome applications from people who have a lived experience – with an understanding of working with or have worked with Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic communities and the importance this brings to building a sustainable organisation that is truly beneficial for the needs of the community.

All applications will be considered solely on merit. Please provide:

- a covering letter (no longer than one page) detailing which role or roles you are interested in, reason why, and your relevant experience and skills.
- a Curriculum Vitae
